## REVISED P-EBT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR

**Virginia's Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT) program** will issue benefits for the current school year to eligible students based on revised federal guidelines.

To qualify for benefits, a school and student must meet the following requirements:



A **school is eligible** if the following conditions are met:



A **student is eligible** if the following conditions are met:

- 1. The school closed or operated at reduced hours for five consecutive days due to a COVID-19-related issue
- **2. and** the school participates in the National School Lunch or School Breakfast Program.

- The student attends a school that has been determined eligible as defined by United States Department of Agriculture guidelines
- 2. and qualifies for free and reduced-price school meals,
- **3. and** was absent from school because of a documented COVID-19-related issue.

The receipt of P-EBT benefits for previous school years does not guarantee eligibility for the 2021-2022 school year. Schools and students must meet all eligibility requirements, which will be determined by information each school/school district provides to the Virginia Department of Social Services.
