<input type="checkbox"/>	Attend the College Fair at RCHS (September)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Compile your list of colleges/universities - think hard about what you want and VISIT!
<input type="checkbox"/>	Take the PSAT in October at RCHS - listen to the announcements for dates and deadlines
<input type="checkbox"/>	Take your first SAT in the Spring
<input type="checkbox"/>	Work hard to keep your grades up! Junior year is IMPORTANT!
<b>SENIOR YEAR</b>	<b>TO DO:</b>

<input type="checkbox"/>	Make a Parchment account and request a transcript to be sent to yourself - CHECK IT!
<input type="checkbox"/>	Fill out Diploma Application (sent to school email)
<input type="checkbox"/>	If you've taken AP or DE classes, fill out the Early College Scholars Application (Due the 1st Friday in September)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Order your cap & gown for Graduation - you MUST have one to participate and prices go up on December 1.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Register for and take the SAT/ACT again if needed
<input type="checkbox"/>	Complete and turn in your Blue Sheet, Brag Sheet, & FERPA form to the counseling office
<input type="checkbox"/>	Arrange for any letters of recommendation from your counselor and teachers
<input type="checkbox"/>	Attend the College Fair at RCHS (September)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Complete any Early Action or Early Decision applications (Common App)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Scholarships - start applying! National ones have deadlines as early as September and October
<input type="checkbox"/>	FAFSA - <a href="http://www.studentaid.gov">www.studentaid.gov</a>

<input type="checkbox"/>	Look for correspondence from colleges and universities you applied to
<input type="checkbox"/>	Request mid-January for midyear transcripts to be sent through Parchment (unless you applied through Common App)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Keep applying for scholarships!
<b>SPRING</b>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Visit colleges and universities you've been accepted to - make your decision!
<input type="checkbox"/>	Turn in any deposits or school-based financial aid forms
<input type="checkbox"/>	Look carefully over any financial aid award letters you receive
<input type="checkbox"/>	Keep applying for scholarships!
<input type="checkbox"/>	Pick up your cap & gown and take your class photo with your peers
<input type="checkbox"/>	Inform your counselor which college or university you are committing to attend
<input type="checkbox"/>	Fill out the Google form Exit Ticket for Senior Year and submit Senior Slide Show Information
<input type="checkbox"/>	Request your final transcript to be sent via Parchment to your chosen school (unless you applied through Common App - your counselor will handle that!)
<input type="checkbox"/>	If you have taken any Dual Enrollment classes, you must request your MGCC transcript through MGCC's Parchment Account to be sent to your chosen college/university.
